Minister	A man undertaking the full roles of ministry within a local Church including teaching, pastoral work and leadership.	Endorsement by 75% of the Church members present at a meeting and voting. Interview by the Ministerial Committee and approval by the Board.	Service of Ordination and Induction with formal vows administered by the Chairman or Deputy Chairman.	Receive papers, attend, contribute and vote.
Senior Minister	A Minister having overall responsibility for the leadership of a Church.	For appointment from within the UEC, or outside of the UEC. Endorsement by 75% of the Church members present at a meeting and voting. Interview by the Ministerial Committee and approval by the Board.	Optional Service of Celebration with formal vows administered by the Chairman or Deputy Chairman.	Receive papers, attend, contribute and vote.
Moderator	A Moderator is a Minister appointed by the UEC Board to a Church without a Minister. He will have the authority of a Minister, and chair any Church meetings. The aim is for the Moderator to guide and help a Church in the appointment of a Minister.	Recommended by the Ministerial Committee to the Board. Written reports to each Ministerial Committee meeting are required. Appointed initially for one year, then reviewed by the Board.	Not applicable	Receive papers, attend and contribute, but not vote.
