ORDINATION AND INDUCTION

Appointment to Pastoral Ministry as a Minister or Associate Minister

INTRODUCTION by the Presiding Minister

The Word of God clearly teaches that the ascended Lord Jesus gives pastors and teachers to His Church. We read in Ephesians 4 v11 and 12:

"It was He Who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the Body of Christ may be built up."

The duties of a Pastor are to be a faithful under-shepherd of that part of the Great Shepherd's flock entrusted to his care through:

- 1. consistent and accurate teaching of the Word of God in all its breadth, applying it to the needs of the believing community,
- 2. the practice of private and corporate prayer,
- 3. the exercise of pastoral care and discipline, and
- 4. together with other leaders of the fellowship, set an example in lifestyle, service and evangelism.

ORDINATION as a Minister of the Union of Evangelical Churches
